Aerobic endurance

Aerobic endurance – how long the body can keep up activities at a low to medium level of intensity before suffering **fatigue**.

Fatigue is when muscles get too tired and no longer work properly.

Aerobic endurance depends on the **cardio-respiratory** system being able to supply oxygen and nutrients to muscles.

"Cardio" – heart
"Respiratory" – breathing

Muscular strength

Muscular strength – the largest force that a muscle, or group of muscles, can produce.

More muscular strength means you can produce more **forceful movements**. This means you can pull, push, lift or throw heavier objects.
